He holds a bachelor's degree in music from Wayne State University in Detroit and is certified in both Pastoral Ministry and Liturgical Ministry, locally by the Archdiocese of Detroit and nationally by the USCCB's Commission on Certification and Accreditation.

A member of the National Advisory Council to the USCCB from 2000 to 2004 and Liturgy & Prayer coordinator for the First National Encuentro for Hispanic Youth and Young Adult Ministry 2006, Santiago is currently Music Director for the National Catholic Council for Hispanic Ministry (NCCHM). He has also participated at various events of the Archdiocese of Detroit as guest conductor, cantor and consultant.

Santiago won three Unity Awards from the UCMVA (United Catholic Music and Video Association) in October 2006, for best international artist, CD and song.

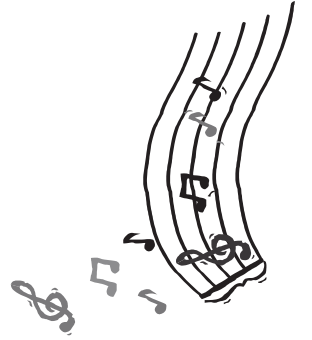

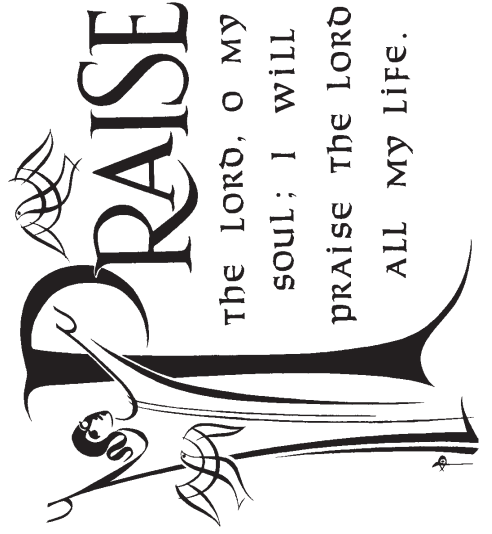
