MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: CALENDAR ADVISORY FOR 2011-2012 – PLEASE SAVE

In accord with the provisions of canon 1246§2 of the Code of Canon Law, which states: “..the Bishop’s conference may, with prior approval of Apostolic See, suppress certain holydays of obligation or transfer them to a Sunday. The precept to attend Mass is abrogated whenever the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God, January 1, the Assumption, or All Saints falls on a Saturday or Monday.”

Sunday is the day on which the paschal mystery is celebrated in light of the apostolic tradition and is to be observed as the foremost Holy Day of Obligation in the universal Church.

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops decrees that the Holy Days of Obligation to be observed in the United States for the remainder of 2011-2012 are as follows:

1. Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception (Thursday, December 8, 2011)
2. Solemnity of Christmas (Sunday, December 25, 2011)
3. Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (Sunday, January 1, 2012)
4. Solemnity of the Epiphany (Sunday, January 8, 2012)
5. Solemnity of the Ascension (Transferred to Sunday, May 20, 2012) (Thursday, May 17, 2012)
6. Solemnity of the Assumption (Wednesday, August 15, 2012)
7. Solemnity of All Saints (Thursday, November 1, 2012)
8. Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception (Saturday, December 8, 2012)
9. Solemnity of Christmas (Tuesday, December 25, 2012)

NOTE: The Solemnity of Corpus Christi shall be observed on the Second Sunday following Pentecost.

This is to inform you that Holy Hope Cemetery in Tucson holds a Mass for the Repose of the Souls of all interred at this cemetery on the 3rd Saturday of each month at 8:00 am. For additional information please visit www.dotcc.org
